Key Notes:

Parents and their children make a family. A family having one or two children is called a small family. Whereas, a family having more than two children is called a big family. If a family have grandparents, parents, uncles, aunties and children together such a family is called a joint family and if one parent with their children live together, such a family is called a nuclear family. The relationship between the members of a family can be known with the help of a family do different works in and outside the family.

1. What is a family?

Ans: A family is a group consisting of two parents and their children living together as a unit.

2. What is a small family?

Ans: A family having one or two children is called a small family.

3. What is a big family?

4. What is a joint family?

Ans: A joint family is a family which includes two or more generation i.e. grandparents (grandfather & grandmother), parents (father & mother), uncles, aunties, brothers and sisters.

5. What is a nuclear family?

Ans: A nuclear family is a family which have only two parents (father and mother) and their children.

6. What is a family tree?

Ans: A family tree is a diagram showing the relationship between people in several generations of a family.




Fig: A Family tree
