Ans : Teak and Sal.

Ans : Narmada and Tapi.

2. Answer the following questions in about- 40 words each :

a) What are the four different season of India ?

Ans : i) Cold season (winter) – December to February

ii) Hot season (summer) – March to May

iii) South- west monsoon season – June to September

iv) Retreating monsoon season – October to November

b) What are the three parallel ranges of the Himalayas ?

Ans : The three parallel ranges of the Himalayas are the Inner or Great Himalaya (Himadri) in the north, the Middle or Lesser Himalaya (Himachal) in the middle and the Outer Himalaya(Siwalik) in the south

c) Where do we find the Tropical evergreen forest in India ?

Ans : Tropical evergreen forests are found in regions where rainfall is heavy. The western slope of the western ghats, the north-eastern hills and Andaman and Nicobar islands are the regions where we find these forests.

d) What are the two island groups of India ?

Ans : The two island groups of India are the Andaman and Nicobar islands in the Bay of Bengal and the Lakshadweep islands in the Arabian sea.
