a) Who were the Bandagans?

Ans- Bandagans were special slaves who were purchased for military services and certain administrative functions.

Ans- He felt that Daulatabad would be more ideal for controlling both north and south India.

c) Name the event which quickened the decline of the Delhi Sultanate.

Ans- Timur's invasion in 1398 AD quickened the decline of Delhi Sultanate.

2 Answer the following questions in about 30/40 words each.

a) State two functions of the Iqtadars.

Ans- The two functions of the Iqtadars are as follows-

1 The Iqtadars were to lead military campaigns and maintain law and order.

2 To collect the revenues of the Iqtas or Lands.

b) How did Ala-Ud-Din Khalji try to control the Iqtadars?

Ans- In order to have effective control over the Iqtadars, the post was made inheritable and Iqtas were assigned for short periods and these conditions were strictly imposed.

c) How did the Delhi sultans try to control the hinterlands of the garrison towns?

Ans- The Delhi sultans in order to control the hinterlands of the garrison towns, led military campaigns along the internal frontier and cleared the forest and expelled the hunter-gatherers from their habitats.

d)How was the market's regulated during the time of Ala-Ud- Din Khalji?

Ans- The market's were regulated in the following manner-

- 1 Three markets selling different commodities were set up and the prices of all commodities were fixed.
