Chapter: 1 Shifting from Place to Place

Key Notes:

A family always grows up and a small new family is separated and shifted. In early times, families moved in search of food and other resources, such people are known as 'Nomads'. At present also, there are many factors which leads to displacement of people from one place to another like construction of dams, flyover or road and various natural calamities like earthquake, floods etc. As a result of global warming many islands will be under water and many people will be displaced as environmental refugees. Displacement also causes lots of problem such as loss of income, abrupt termination of education, deterioration of environmental and health services, housing problems, psychological problems etc.

1. How does a family grow?
