EXERCISES

Q1. List down actions that could be taken in your schools and homes to reduce vulnerability to earthquake damage. Discuss with your teacher and parents.

Ans:- The best remedial action to reduce the vulnerability to earthquake, whether in our homes or school, is to make the buildings earthquake resistant. Engineered structures are necessary to withstand ground shaking. We must analyze the soil type before construction and avoid building structures on soft soil.

Before a building is constructed, the building plans have to be checked by the Municipality according to the laid down bylaws.

Public awareness is to be created through sensitization and training programmes for Architects, Builders, Contractors, Designers, Engineers, House owners, Masons etc.

Q2. Write the name of the States of India prone to earthquakes?

Ans:- The earthquake zone covers all the states of North-East region, viz., Arunachal Pradesh, Assam, Manipur, Meghalaya, Mizoram, Nagaland, Sikkim and Tripura. Besides, some other ststes along the Himalayan foothills such as Uttar Pradesh, Uttarkhand, Himachal Pradesh, Punjab and Haryana are also prone to earthquakes.
