Q1. Now, what would happen to the donkey when it dipped into the river? Why?

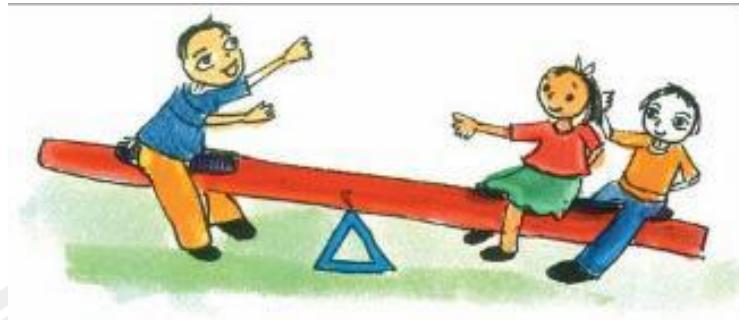
Ans: After the donkey dips in a river. The sacks of woollen cloth become heavy on absorbing water. So, the donkey felt heavier.

Q1(a). Can you tell why? Circle the correct answer. Raju is heavier/lighter than Rani





Ans: Raju is heavier than Rani, as he is heavy enough to pull down the see-saw on his side.



Q2. Can you tell why the see-saw turned this way? Raju is heavier/lighter than Rani and Aslam together.





Ans: Raju is lighter than Rani and Aslam together, as the total weight of Rani and Aslam is more than the weight of Raju.

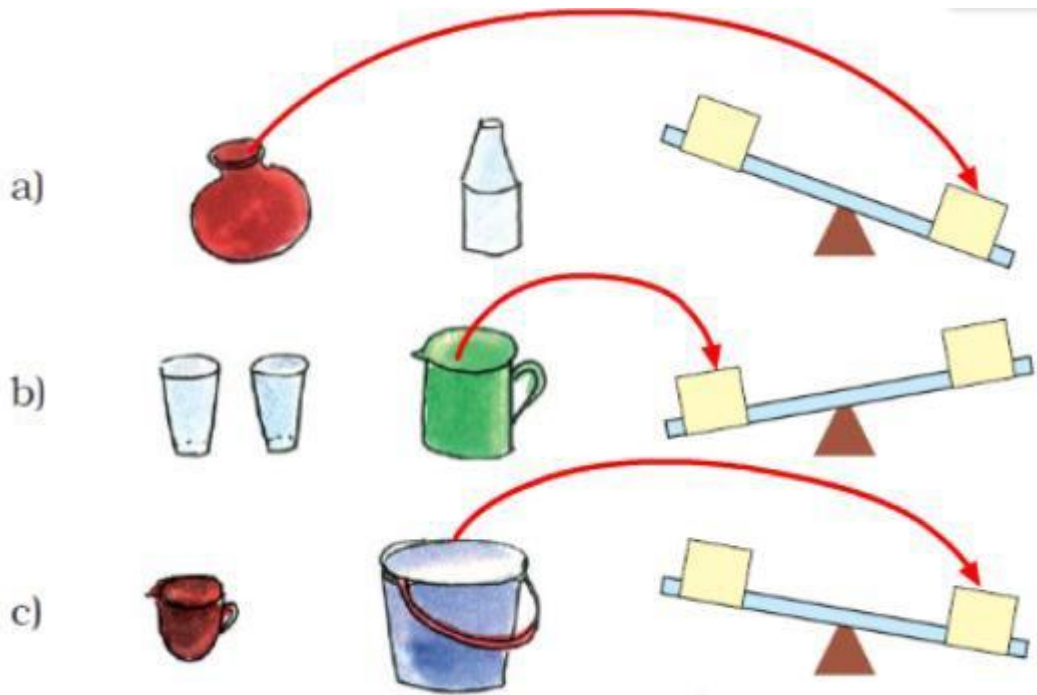

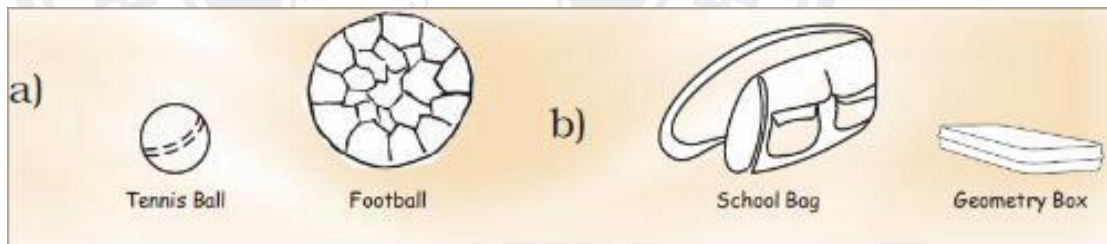

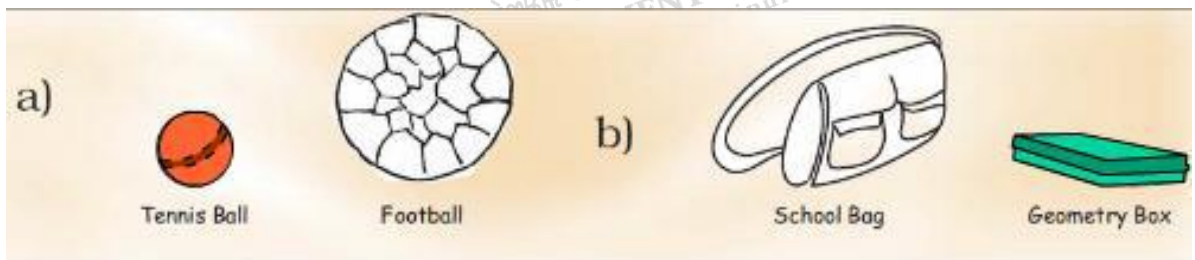
