EXERCISE:

I. Answer the following questions:

(i) What does the poet like to see in the sky?

Ans. The poet likes to see the clouds in the sky.

ii) Count how many times the poet uses – “I like”.

Ans. The poet uses – “I like” five times.

iii) When is the poet glad?

Ans. The poet is glad when clouds are in the sky.

iv) pick out two words from the poem which refer to shapes.

Ans. Two words which refer to shares are faces and maps.

v). Make a list of three things you see in the sky.

Ans. Three things that we see in the sky are Sun, Moon and star
