Ans: The development of tourism has been particularly conspicuous in the cities and countries where large numbers of tourists emanate and where tour operators, governments and other economic agencies compete through advertising tourist destinations, facilities and services to attract tourists and make a visible impact.

(ii) With what has the expansion of tourism coincided?

Ans: The expansion of tourism has coincided with the significant cultural, political and environmental changes identified with post industrial technology of the past few decades.

(iii) How is Manipur an ideal place for promotion of tourism as an industry?
